All Nursery children are invited even if they do not normally attend Nursery on a Friday. There are a variety of options if your child does not normally attend Friday. They can either come in for the full day or you can drop them off at 1pm for pick up at 3.30pm. If they normally attend Nursery Friday mornings, they can stay for the full day. Please let us know what you would like your child to do.

Children will need to wear clothes that can get muddy, such as an old pair of joggers, t-shirt and jumper. Please check the weather forecast beforehand as children will be outside come rain or shine. If it is raining, they need to wear wellies and bring waterproofs and a spare change of clothes. If it is sunny, they will need a sunhat and trainers. Please put sun-cream on before school, as we cannot apply it for the children. Water bottles are still needed but we will provide snacks for the children.

Important information regarding school trips

Please note:

As part of the school's revised Charging and Remission policy, if a parent is experiencing difficulties in making the full contribution towards a trip, please talk to Louise Brown, in confidence, for assistance.

In addition, the school may be able to offer financial assistance towards the cost of a school trip and towards board and lodging on a residential trip, provided that a parent can prove that they are in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
