Departure

- Monday 23rd May
- Depart from **DENTON PRIMARY SCHOOL**

Tuesday 24th May

- **Land's End & Tate St Ives**
 - Focus: Art & Geography
- **Morning at Land's End**
 - Visit the signpost, sketching the cliffs, explore the land, bird watching (binoculars), picnic
- **Afternoon at Tate St Ives and Beach**
 - Sketching and art appreciation. Fun on the beach!

Wednesday 25th May

- **St Michael's Mount and Seal Sanctuary**
- **Morning at St Michaels Mount**
 - Focus: History & Art
 - Walk the causeway. Visit the gardens. Climb to the castle. Sketch the plants and wildlife. Picnic. Playing on the beach.
- **Afternoon at Seal Sanctuary**
 - Focus: Global
 - Workshop – impact of plastic on marine life.
 - Time to explore and meet the animals.

Thursday 26th May

- **Newquay Zoo & Beech**
- **Morning and early afternoon at Newquay Zoo**
 - Learning about conservation, sketching animals, picnic.
- **Beach Time**
 - Building sandcastles, playing in the sea, chilling out and reading a book.

Friday 27th May

- **Eden Project & Home**
 - Focus: Ecological
- **Morning at Eden Project**
 - Visit the Rainforest and Mediterranean dome. Learn about conservation. Attend a workshop all about Darwin.
- **Leave the Eden Project at 1:00pm**
- **Arrive back at Denton Primary School at approximately 7pm – traffic dependent**
- **Ensure that we have up to date contacts – we will text/email with updates on ETA.**
- **You can pick up from The Eden Project at 12:00. With prior agreement. Confirm by Monday 16th May.**

Kit list
